

Usage of Playing Fields at the Maguire Campus

The following outdoor athletic activities are anticipated for the playing fields of the Maguire Campus during the fall and spring semesters. For the fall semester, outdoor athletic activities generally begin in mid-August and end in early December. For the spring semester, outdoor athletic activities generally begin in mid-February and end in late May. The number of practices and home games varies from year to year. The following is representative of a given academic year.

A. Intercollegiate Varsity Athletics: women's field hockey, women's softball and men's baseball games and practices. Currently, weekday home games begin at 3 p.m. or 4 p.m. and weekend home games begin at noon or 1 p.m.

1. Women's Field Hockey: Eight home games: five on weekdays and three on weekends. Home games will be played during the fall semester on the hockey field near City Avenue. Games generally last one hour and thirty minutes. Practices occur on weekdays and weekends during both the fall and spring semesters.

2. Men's Baseball: Twenty-four home games: thirteen on weekdays and eleven on weekends. Home games will be played during the spring semester on the baseball field near Latches Lane. Games generally last three hours. Practices occur on weekdays and weekends during both the fall and spring semesters.

3. Women's Softball: Eleven game days (six single games and five doubleheaders): six on weekdays and five on weekends. Home games will be played during the spring semester on the softball field near Berwick Road. Single games generally last one hour and forty-five minutes. Doubleheaders generally last four hours. Practices occur on weekdays and weekends during both the fall and spring semesters.

B. Intercollegiate Club Athletics: men's baseball, women's field hockey, women's lacrosse, men's lacrosse, women's soccer, men's soccer and coed ultimate frisbee games and practices. Currently, weekday home games begin at 3 p.m. or 4 p.m. and weekend home games begin at noon or 1 p.m.

1. Men's Baseball: Six home games: two on weekdays and four on weekends. Home games will be played during the fall and spring semesters on the baseball field near Latches Lane. Practices occur on weekdays and weekends.

2. Women's Field Hockey: Four home games, which occur on weekends. Home games will be played during the fall and spring semesters on the hockey field near City Avenue. Practices occur on weekdays and weekends.

3. Women's Lacrosse: Three home games, which occur on weekends. Home games will be played during the fall and spring semesters on the hockey field near City Avenue. Practices occur on weekdays and weekends.

4. Men's Lacrosse: Six home games: three on weekdays and three on weekends. Home games will be played during the fall and spring semesters on the hockey field near City Avenue. Practices occur on weekdays and weekends.

5. Women's Soccer: Four home games, which occur on weekends. Home games will be played during the fall and spring semesters on the hockey field near City Avenue and on Finnesey Field on the Philadelphia Campus. Practices occur on weekdays and weekends.

6. Men's Soccer: Four home games: two on weekdays and two on weekends. Home games will be played during the fall and spring semesters on the hockey field near City Avenue and on Finnesey Field on the Philadelphia Campus. Practices occur on weekdays and weekends.

7. Coed Ultimate Frisbee: Two home games, which occur on weekends. Home games will be played during the fall and spring semesters on the grass intramural field near City Avenue. Practices occur on weekdays and weekends.

C Intramural Athletics: flag football, softball, kickball (tentative) and soccer. Intramural athletics are coed. Games are generally played between noon and 7 p.m.

1. Flag Football: Flag football games will be played during the fall semester on the field near Berwick Road. Practices and games occur on weekdays and weekends.

2. Softball: Softball games will be played during the spring semester on the softball field near Berwick Road, the baseball field near Latches Lane and the intramural field near City Avenue. Practices and games occur on weekdays and weekends.

3. Kickball: This is a new spring semester intramural sport. The location of the games has not been chosen. Practices and games occur on weekdays and weekends.

4. Soccer: Soccer games will be played during the spring semester on one of the fields near City Avenue. Practices and games occur on weekdays and weekends.

D. Other Athletic Events: Community athletic events continue to be played on the playing fields consistent with those commonly associated with like uses of similar properties, By way of an example, summer camps for non-University students continue to be operated on the Maguire Campus. These events occur during daylight hours.
